<b>Train configuration</b>	Each TGV Lyria has 8 carriages which include: 3 First class coaches, 4 Standard class coaches and 1 bar-buffet carriage. Both TGV Lyria and TGV Duplex services operate the Paris-Geneva service. TGV EST trains, designed by Christian Lacroix, operate the Paris-Basel-Zurich route.

<b>First Class</b>	<p><b>LyriaPremiere</b> service is offered on all TGV Lyria services. LyriaPremiere includes a <b>gourmet cold meal</b> served at your seat. Breakfast, Brunch, Lunch, a Light meal or Dinner will be served depending on the time of day.</p> <p>On board bilingual staff will be available throughout the journey.</p>

<b>First Class</b>	<p><b>Complimentary welcome soft drink</b></p> <p><b>Power points</b> (220V) - not available on some Paris - Geneva services.</p> <p><b>Free onboard Taxi booking service.</b> Taxi fee payable. Service available on all TGV Lyria services, except TGV 9274 and 6588 that operate on Sundays.</p> <p><b>International newspapers and magazines.</b></p>
<b>Standard Class</b>	<p><b>Buffet-bar</b> carriage where customers can purchase drinks, hot and cold meals, child meals, sandwiches and salads. Located in carriage 4 or 14. Euros and Swiss Francs accepted only. Paris Metro tickets are on sale at the buffet-bar for 1,60 Euros or 2,80 CHF.</p> <p><b>2 Office rooms</b> are available in carriages 6 and 7 on Paris - Basel/Zurich services.</p> <p>Train announcements in French, German and English</p>
<b>Disabled facilities</b>	<p>Wheelchair and Companion space in <b>First class</b> (in Coaches 1 and 11). Wheelchairs with small dimensions are available to use onboard - to be requested once onboard. Disabled toilet located next to Wheelchair space. Manual and electric wheelchairs are accepted on board provided their dimensions do not exceed 125x75cm.</p>
<b>Family space and nursery</b>	<p>There is a <b>Family space and Nursery</b> in <b>Standard class</b>. The family seating area consists of 4 seats around a foldable table. The nursery area is located within close proximity of the Family space.</p> <p><b>Baby changing facilities</b>, including a baby changing table and bottle warmer, are available in the nursery.</p>
<b>Smoking</b>	All Lyria trains are entirely <b>non-smoking</b>
<b>Luggage</b>	<b>2 bags/suitcases per passenger plus 1 piece of hand luggage.</b> Skis and snowboards are accepted on board and count towards the luggage allowance.
<b>Bicycles</b>	Some TGV Lyria trains accept fully assembled bicycles. The cost of a bicycle space is around £10 and must be reserved at time of booking. There are 4 bicycle spaces situated in coaches 8/18 and 1/11. Alternatively, bicycles may be carried free of charge in a bike bag whose dimensions do not exceed 120x90cm. This counts as one piece of luggage.
<b>Domestic animals</b>	Domestic animals are permitted onboard TGV Lyria provided other passengers do not object. Dogs must be muzzled and on a lead. Small domestic animals must be carried in a pet carrier (with dimensions no greater than 45x30x25cm and no heavier than 6kg). Guide dogs travel for free and do not require a ticket. <b>Maximum of 2 dogs or 2 pet carriers or 1 dog and 1 pet carrier per passenger.</b>
<b>Toilets</b>	Toilets are located at the end of each carriage.
